In the morning, residents took part in a light-hearted quiz in the café, alongside themed cupcakes and fresh coffee. It was a relaxed start to the day and well received by all.

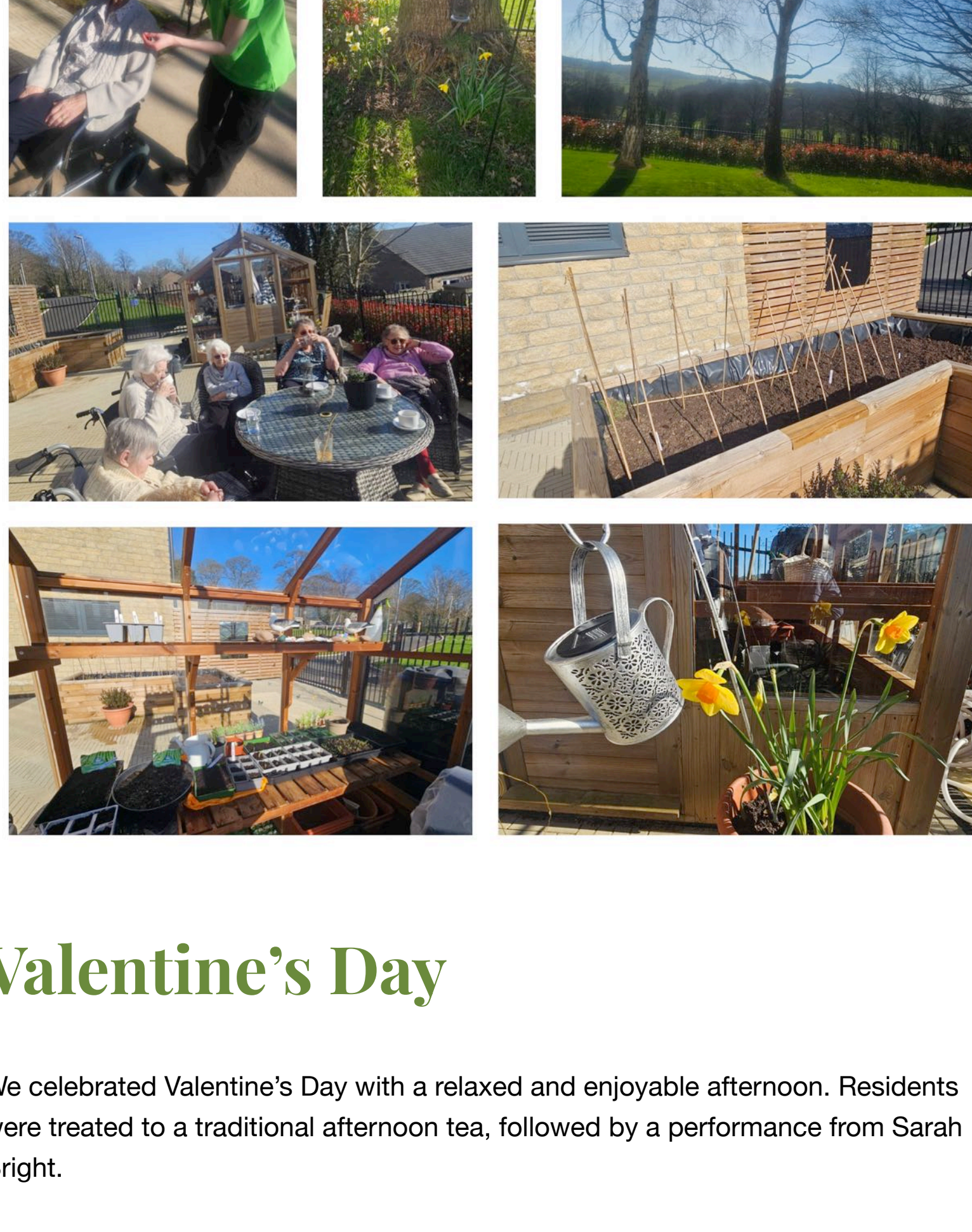

It has been lovely to spend more time outdoors as the weather begins to improve. Residents have enjoyed getting out into the gardens and helping prepare the space for the months ahead.

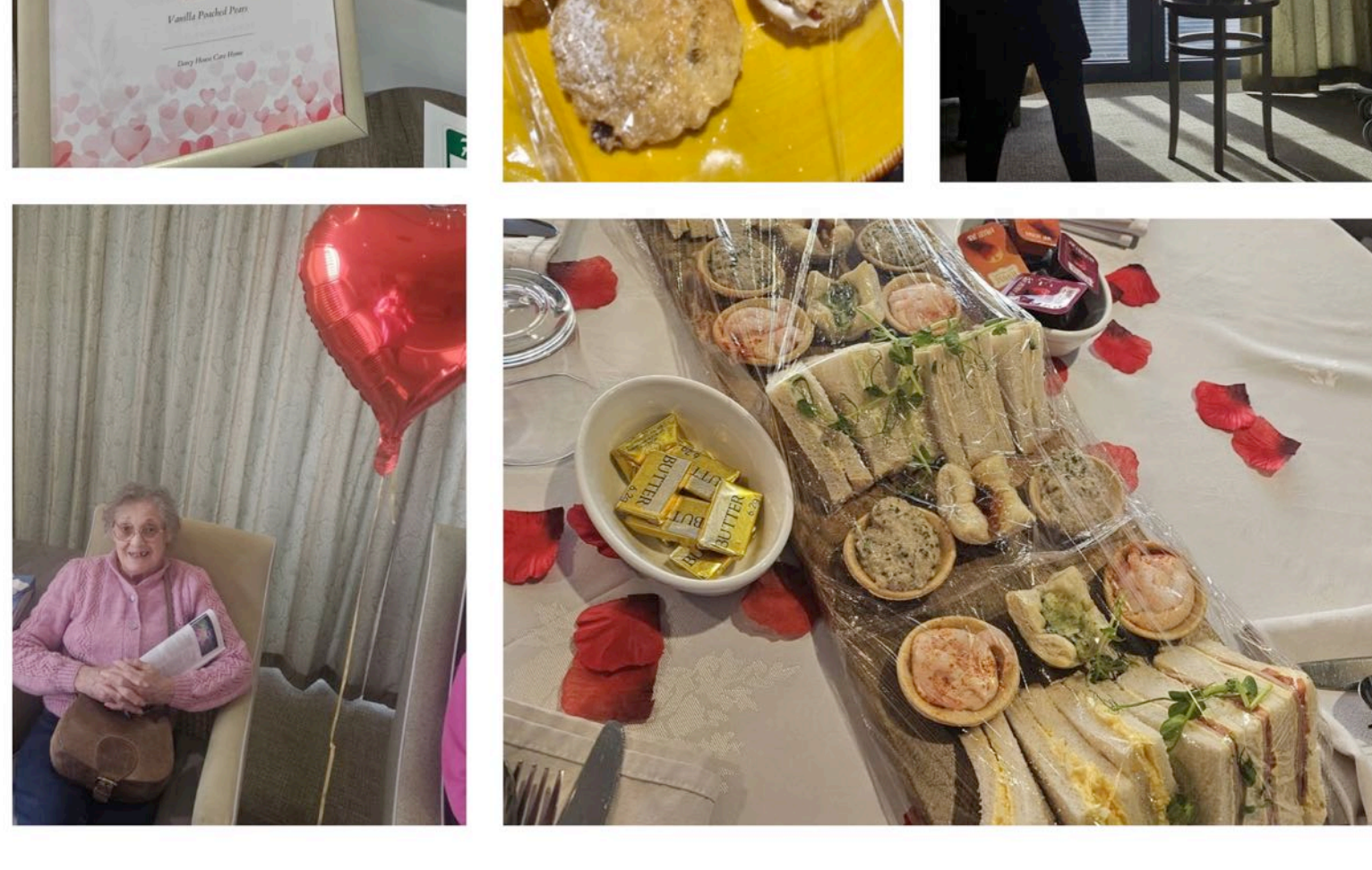
The sunshine has certainly been a welcome change, and we look forward to making the most of it as we move towards summer.

Ed – Activities Co-ordinator

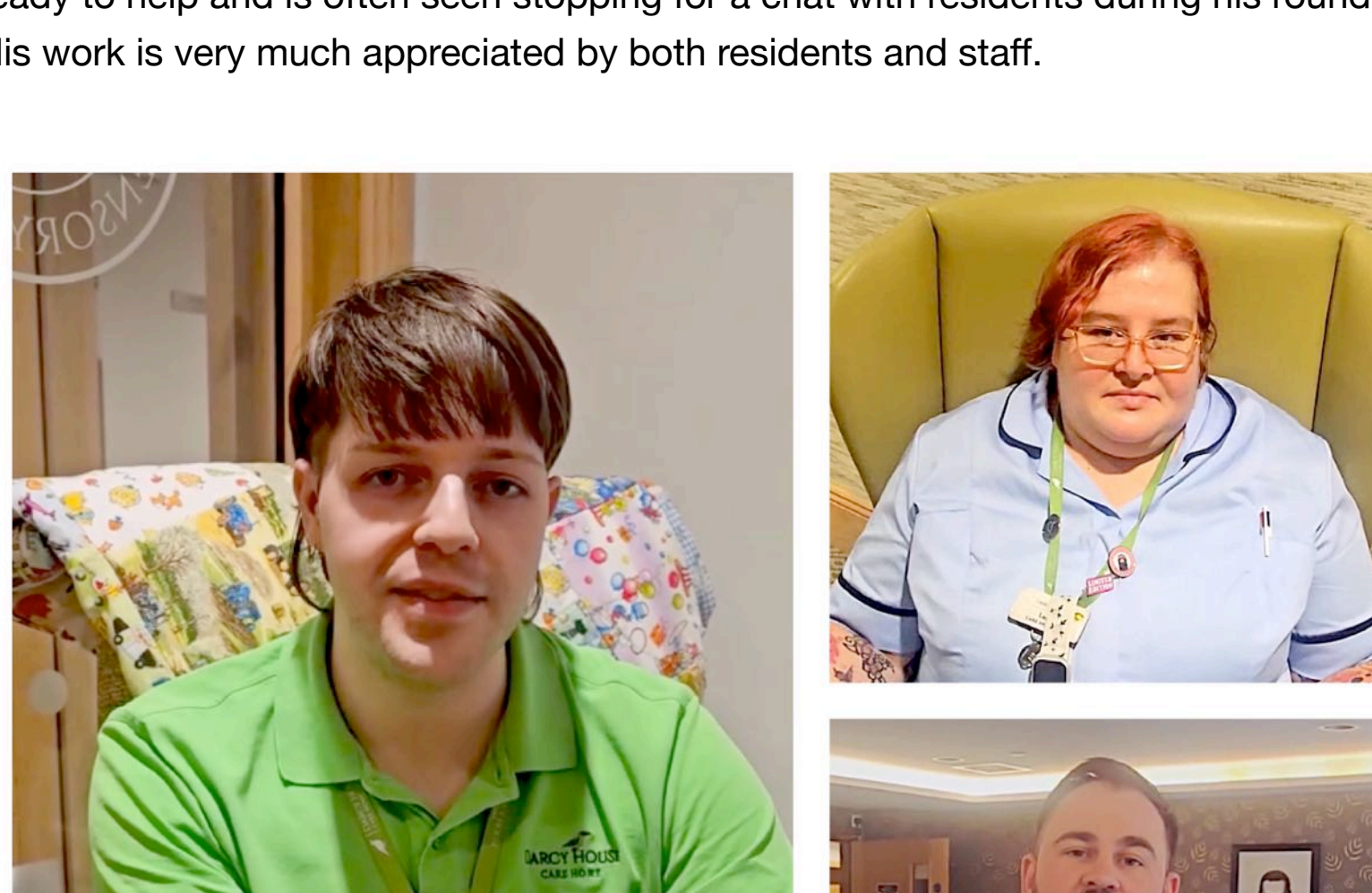
